



Nozstock Festival is passionate about the environment and is striving to be as sustainable as possible.

Transport

We want to make it easier for people to reach the festival in a sustainable way, and reward those that do.

To achieve this we will;

- Run the Nozstock Cycle Challenge – a promotion for people that want to organise a group cycle ride.
- Improve cycle parking at the festival to ensure safe storage once cyclists reach the site.
- Run a bookable bus service from the major train stations (Hereford and Worcester) to the festival site. Check the Directions Page for details.
- Run a free shuttle bus between Bromyard and the festival site.
- Promote and encourage car sharing: National www.liftshare.com Local www.twoshare.co.uk
- For the first time we will be charging for car parking; this is to encourage car sharing, and provide revenue to pay for future green initiatives. Purchasing a car parking ticket in advance will be half price (£5) or full price on arrival (£10).

Waste

We want to be responsible with our waste and recycle as much as possible.

- As in previous years, all waste will be sorted and recycled off site – this is the most cost effective method for our festival.
- Awareness of our waste policy will be raised through advertising at bin sites and through the programme.
- All customers will be given bin bags on arrival
- There is a no glass policy on site. All glass will be confiscated.
- A team of litter pickers will patrol the festival site and camping area, and encourage people to dispose of their litter properly.
- Campsite competition: A team of judges will roam the camping fields, searching for the best campsite, and penalise those messy campers with forfeits.

Traders

- Only compostable disposable cups, plates and cutlery are to be used by stall holders in the festival site. The use of plastic cups, plates and cutlery is not permitted. Some supplies of compostables will be available from the wholesaler.
- Stall holders are responsible for keeping an area 10m in front of their stall / area of activity free of litter.
- A deposit of £100 is required to make sure food traders leave their site clean and litter free after the event.

Energy

We want to be energy conscious and reduce our carbon emissions year on year. We want to encourage use of renewable technologies and green fuels.

- This will be the first year of measuring energy usage, with the aim of then reducing it in subsequent years.
- Local recycled biodiesel will be sourced to be used as a trial in some generators on site.

Traders:

- Preference will be given to stall holders supplying some of their energy from renewable or clean sources.

Procurement

- Nozstock will endeavour to source its own food and products locally / organically / fair trade.
- Preference will be given to traders sourcing food and products locally / organically / fair trade.
